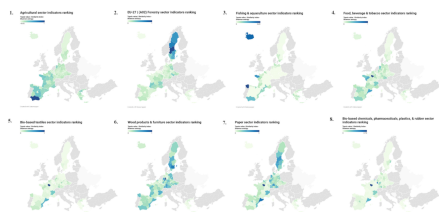

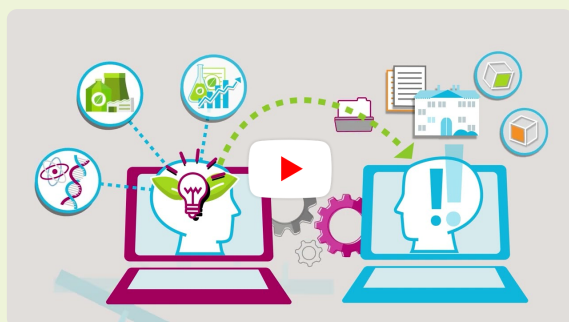
New publication on Multi-Criteria Assessment
